WHEREAS, Millie H. Wakefield, Individually, and as General Guardian for
Charles Wakefield, a minor, and Lois Wakefield, Robbie Lee Bowers, Gladys
Wakefield, Thelma Wakefield, Ruth Wakefield, William Wakefield, Ernestine
Wakefield Jones, Frances Wakefield McKinney and Dorothy Wakefield White,
on or about the 17th day of March in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and fifty exhibited their
complaint in the County Court of ~~Common Pleas~~ for the County aforesaid, against

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to
be heard on the 19th day of July 1950.,
and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$3506.66
HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said Ernestine Wakefield Jones

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with the improvements
thereon, situate, lying and being on the Northern side of Bramlett Road
in subdivision of Morgan Hill Addition, City View, near the City of
Greenville, in Greenville Township, in the County of Greenville, in the
State of South Carolina; being shown and delineated as Lot No. 59 on plat
of property of Mary W. Morgan known as "Morgan Hill Addition" (name of
engineer not appearing), made in May 1902, recorded in Plat Book "A", at
Pages 68 and 69; and being bounded on the West by Lot No. 58, now or
formerly owned by Ed Foster, on the North by Lot No. 39, now or formerly
owned by W. R. Henson, and on the East by Lot No. 60, now or formerly
owned by C. M. White, and on the South by Bramlett Road, and having the
following metes and bounds, to-wit:
