WHEREAS, MRS. J. L. MCINTYRE OF SAVANNAH, GEORGIA SEP 5 2 56 PM 1950
AND
MRS. VERA M. YOUNG OF GREENVILLE, S. C. OLLIE FARNSWORTH R.M.C.

did on the 1st, day of September, 19 50, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

- FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.
- SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is DUNEAN SODA SHOP, INC.
- THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.
- FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is retail soda shop with sundries.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) - - - - - Dollars payable by transfer of assets of partnership of McIntyre and Young, trading as Dunean Soda Shop, including merchandise and furniture and fixtures.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Fifty (50) of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) - - - - - Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 22nd day of August, 19 50, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: Mrs. J. L. McIntyre and Mrs. Vera M. Young and Edward Wimberly Clay

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, Edward Wimberly Clay ; as Vice-President, Ned Prothro Clay ; as Secretary, Ned Prothro Clay ; as Treasurer, Edward Wimberly Clay

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1942, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Greenville Piedmont a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the afore-said Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
