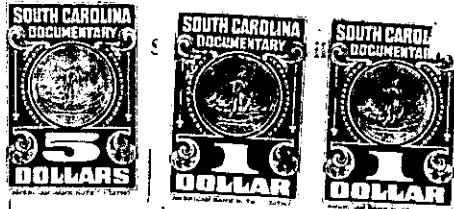
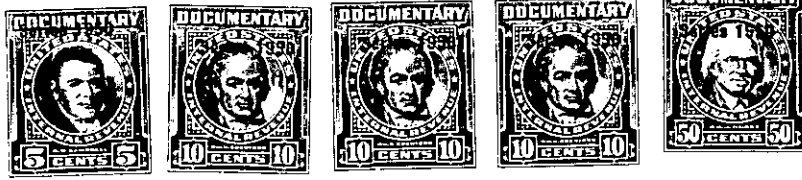

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, being about three quarter mile from the Greenville  
Court house, on Honor-Street, off the Dunham Bridge Road, or better known  
as the Old Anderson Road;
