All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the West side of Byrd Boulevard (sometimes referred to as Ridge Drive or Club Drive) near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot 15 and the Southern one-half of Lot 14, on plat of property of J. L. Bussey made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, April 1924, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "F", at page 220, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Byrd Boulevard in the center of the front line of Lot 14, said pin being 188.92 feet South from the Southwest

corner of the intersection of Sirrine Drive and Byrd Boulevard, and running thence with the West side of Byrd Boulevard, S 23-38 E 113.35 feet to an iron pin; thence S 63-50 W 200 feet to an iron pin at rear corner of Lot 11; thence with the line of Lot 11, N 23-38 W 114.37 feet to an iron pin in the center of the rear line of Lot 14; thence through the center of Lot 14, N 64-05 E 200 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Byrd Boulevard, the beginning corner.
