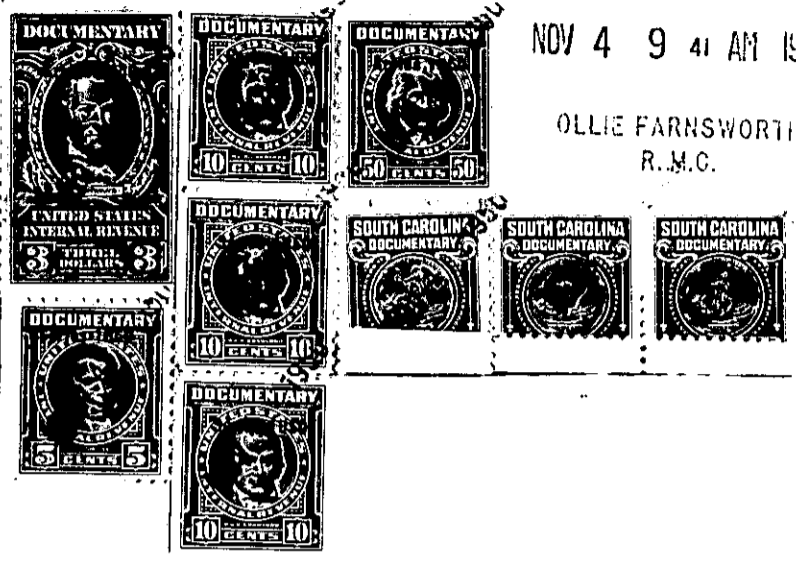

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, M. C. Woodson, of the County of Greenville,

in the state aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Thirty One Hundred (\$3100.00) Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Louis Martin Gilliam, Jr.

( the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Louis Martin Gilliam, Jr., his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain lot or parcel of land situate in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, described as follows : Beginning at a corner in center of the Pelzer-Holliday Bridge Highway running thence southward for a distance of three hundred (300) feet to a corner, thence east one hundred twenty five (125) feet to corner, thence north three hundred (300) feet to corner in center of said Highway, thence west along said Highway one hundred twenty five (125) feet to the beginning corner, bounded by lands of Charles Knight Cochran, M. C. Woodson and the said Pelzer-Hollidays Bridge Highway. This being a portion of the tract of land conveyed to me by deed of R. L. Sartain, dated July 18th 1947, of record in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County, S. C., July 21st 1947, in Vol. 315, page 337.
