

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Henry Martin, his Heirs, and
Assigns, Forever: *my 1/2 interest in and to*

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, situate on the North side of Sycamore Drive,
about 2½ miles Southeast of the Greenville County Court House, and
being East of the Laurens Road, in Greenville County, I. C., known
and designated as Lot No. 137, on plat of East Lynne Addition made
by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, May, 1933, recorded in the R. I. C.
Office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, at page 220, and having,
according to said plat, the following metes and bounds: -

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Sycamore Drive, joint
corner of Lots Nos. 135 and 137, and running thence along the joint
line of said lots N. 28-50 E. 150 feet to an iron pin, joint rear
corner of Lots Nos. 132, 135, 136, and 137; thence along the rear
line of Lot No. 136, S. 61-10 E. 50 feet to an iron pin, joint rear
corner of Lots Nos. 136, 137, 138 and 139; thence along the joint
line of Lots Nos. 137 and 138, S. 28-50 E. 150 feet to an iron pin
in the North side of Sycamore Drive, joint corner of Lots Nos. 137
and 138; thence along the North side of Sycamore Drive, N. 37-10 E.
50 feet to the point of beginning

This property is sold subject to the following restrictions, which
are declared to be for the benefit of all lot owners as shown in
said plat hereinabove referred to: -

1. The lot herein conveyed shall never be sold, divided or
otherwise disposed of to negroes or persons of African descent.
2. The lot herein conveyed shall be used exclusively for
residential purposes.
3. No residence shall be erected on said lot costing less
than \$1,250.00.
4. No building shall be erected on said lot closer than
25 feet.
