We, Calvin E. Jenkins and Helen Rebecca Jenkins, of Greenville County,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of

Forty-Seven Hundred and No/100 - - - - - (\$4700.00) - - - - Dollars

to us paid by Jake W. Hollingsworth

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jake W. Hollingsworth, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Paris Mountain Township, known as a part of the land conveyed to Elizabeth Brown by deed from B. F. Marchbanks, adjoining lands of Helen Rebecca Jenkins and Reedy River Church lands:

BEGINNING on an iron pin on the Old Buncombe Road; thence running N. 43 E. 2.90 chains to an iron pin; thence N. 59 W. 2.55 chains to an iron pin on Reedy River Church lands; thence with this line, S. 12 W. 2.75 chains to an iron pin in center of Old Buncombe Road; thence with said road, S. 52 E. 1.13 chains to the beginning corner and containing one-half acre, more or less.

The above described lot of land is the same conveyed to Helen Rebecca Jenkins by Elizabeth Brown by her deed dated November 5, 1943 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 260, at page 76, the said Helen Rebecca Jenkins having conveyed and undivided one-half interest in said property on July 22, 1946 to Calvin E. Jenkins by deed recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 297, at page 373.

The grantee is to pay taxes for the year 1950, said taxes having been pro-rated as of this date.
