WHITE, his heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, lying and being situate on the Northern side of Potomac Avenue, within the limits of the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being known and designated as Lots #188 and #189, Pleasant Valley, according to plat prepared by Dalton & Neves in April, 1946, as revised through February, 1950, as recorded in the R.A.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "P", at page 88, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Potomac Avenue at joint front corner of Lots #188 and #187; thence N. 0-08 W. 160 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots #188 and #187; thence S. 89-52 W. 120 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots #189 and #190; thence S. 0-08 E. 160 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of Potomac Avenue, joint front corner of Lots #189 and #190, thence along said Avenue, N. 89-52 E. 120 feet to an iron pin at joint front corner of Lots #188 and #187, the point of beginning.
