NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Preesents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release Mrs. Lila S. Goddard, all the right, title and interest of Mrs. Mollie Susan Smith the same being an undivided one-third interest in and to following described real estate:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the Fifth Ward of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, South Carolina and being known and disignated as Lot No. 3 on plat made by J. N. Southern, D.S., on March 13, 1908, recorded in the R. M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A" at page 229.

BEGINNING at a point on the south side of Arlington Avenue, which point is 150 feet northwest of the intersection of Arlington Avenue and Calhoun Street, and running thence S. 18 W. 175 feet; thence S. 72 E. 50 feet; thence N. 18 E. 175 feet; thence N. 72 W. along Arlington Avenue to the point of beginning, and being identically the same lot conveyed to W. H. Smith by Frank Ferguson by deed dated July 3, 1909, recorded in the R. M. C. Office in Deed Book 4 at page 511.

The consideration for the above conveyance is \$900.00, which amount was paid direct to L. Y. Smith, Committee for Mrs. Mollie Susan Smith, in accordance with the Court's Decree in the above entitled action.
