

and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land with the building and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the Northeast side of Duncan Chapel Road, in Paris Mountain Township, in Greenville County, South Carolina, and having, according to a survey made by Piedmont Engineering Service, November 1950, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of the Duncan Chapel Road, corner of lands now or formerly of W. L. Bridwell, and running thence along the line of said Bridwell property and line of property formerly of C. W. Quinn, N 43-12 E 2719.3 feet to an iron pin on the Western edge of the right-of-way of the Greenville-Northern Railroad, also corner of lands now or formerly of Moody; thence along the line of Moody property, N 57-29 W 501.83 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Edgar B. League property, N 63-57 W 380.95 feet to an iron pin at corner of lands now or formerly of J. B. S. and Margaret C.
