THIS LEASE, Made this the 12th day of October, 1950, by RIEGEL TEXTILE CORPORATION, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Delaware, hereinafter called the "Mills", to DUKE POWER COMPANY, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New Jersey, hereinafter called the "Power Company",

WITNESSETH:

That in consideration of One (\$1.00) Dollar in hand paid to the Mills by the Power Company, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Mills does hereby lease, for the period and subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter set out, to the Power Company, that certain lot of land lying and being in or near the Town of Fork Shoals, Greenville County, South Carolina, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at the northwest corner of the lot heretofore leased by the Mills to the Power Company for substation purposes, and running thence with the line of said lot S. 7 - 49 E., 50 feet; thence 3 new lines as follows: (1) S. 32 - 11 W., 57 feet; (2) N. 7 - 49 W., 50 feet; (3) N. 82 - 11 E., 57 feet to the point of BEGINNING, all as is shown by red lines on print dated August 9, 1950, revised August 22, 1950, hereto attached and made a part hereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the aforesaid premises unto the Power Company for the purpose of installing, operating and maintaining thereon its electrical apparatus and other property and transmitting electricity to said lot and distributing the same therefrom.

Title to all property placed or installed upon said premises by the Power Company shall at all times be and remain in the Power Company and the Power Company shall at any and all times during the continuance of this lease, and at the termination thereof, have the right to enter said premises and remove same.

This lease shall continue in force so long as the Power Company furnishes electric service to the system now operated by Laurens Electric
