1950, the following metes and bounds, to-wit: BEGINNING at a point on the Northeast bank of the county road above mentioned, in line of property now or formerly of w. C. Hawkins, also corner of lands now or formerly of Jesse E. League, and running thence along line of Hawkins property, S 22-01 W 1541.44 feet to an iron pin in line of property formerly of Hester; thence along Hester line, N 56-37 W 209.3 feet to an iron pin; thence still along Hester line, S 23-43 W 209.9 feet to an iron pin in line of property formerly of Mary B. Roy League, N 2-33 E 78.5 feet to an iron pin; thence still along L. Roy League property, crossing said county road again, S 73-31 £ 485.02 feet to an iron pin, corner of property now or formerly of M.
