Know All Men by These Presents: That we, I.B. Dobson, Individually and as Executor of the Will of R.A. Dobson, deceased, and L.M. Dobson as Executor of said Will, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and Fifty-five (\$555.00) in the State aforesaid, DOLLARS,

Lloyd L. Taylor to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lloyd L. Taylor and his heirs and assigns:

All that certain parcel or lot of land situated about one mile South of the City of Greer, Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, designated as Lots Nos. 23, 24 and 25 of Pleasant Heights Development, property of R.A. and I.B. Dobson, according to survey and plat thereof by H.L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, dated September 4, 1950, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the New Pelham Road and Oakland Avenue, and running thence along said New Pelham Road, S. 6.00 E. 100 feet to stake; thence along said road, S. 16.00 E. 100 feet to stake, corner of Lot No. 26; thence along the line of Lot No. 26, S. 74.15 E. 200 feet to stake on line of Lot No. 34; thence along line of Lot No. 34, N. 16.00 W. 100 to stake, corner of Lot No. 22; thence along the line of Lot No. 22, N. 53.30 W. 196 feet to stake on Oakland Avenue; thence along said Oakland Avenue, N. 83.35 E. 341 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described property is sold subject to the following restrictions: No beer, wine or alcoholic liquors shall be sold or stored upon the premises described, and no dance halls or public places of a similar classification shall be permitted to operate thereon. Any violation of these restrictions shall entitle the grantors or any other persons owning property in this development to injunctive relief against the same and to damages for violation thereof.
