Duncan, in the state aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One and no/100 Dollars (\$1.00) and the mutual considerations as herein set forth, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Mac C. Duncan, as Trustee, the following described property, to-wit:
