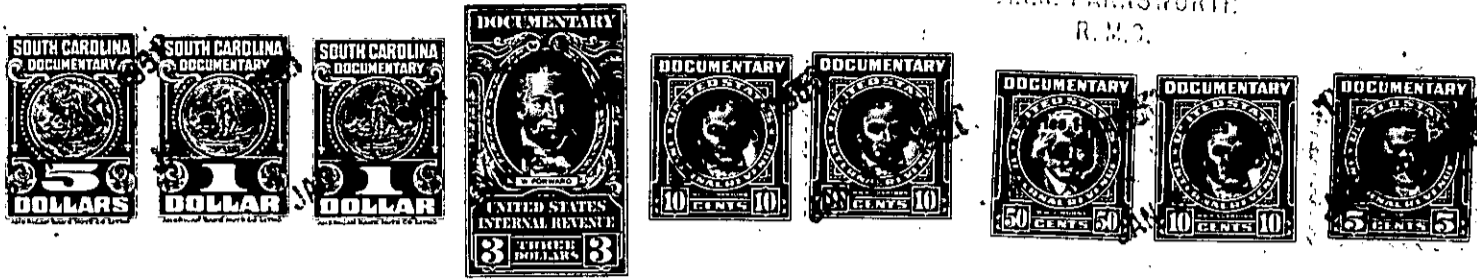

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Nora A. Odom, McNeil Odom, B.J. Odom, Jr., Joyce Odom, Hendrix R. Odom, Williadene Odom Moore and Jewel Odom Smith;

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand Three Hundred Forty-two and 25/100 (\$3,342.25) dollars and the assumption of mortgage held by The Federal Land Bank of Columbia in the amount of \$857.75 Dollars

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by James L. Stewart

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James L. Stewart and his heirs and assigns:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, containing Forty (40) Acres; more or less, lying on the Gap Creek Road and about one-fourth mile southeast from Lenoah School, bounded on the north by lands of Homer Fowler and Fred Sudduth, on the east by lands of Fred Sudduth, on the south by lands of Kirkland Brown, and on the west by Kirkland Brown, and having the following courses and distances according to a plat prepared by W. P. Morrow, Surveyor, dated August, 1942, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in center of Gap Creek Road, the north-western corner of said tract, and runs thence S. 29 1/2 E. 479 feet; thence S. 35 1/4 E. 179 feet; thence S. 49 1/2 W. 248 feet; thence S. 10 W. 330 feet to the center of a branch; thence down the meanders of said branch S. 46 E. 130 feet, S. 43 1/2 E. 136 feet, S. 37 E. 103 feet, S. 42 1/2 E. 83 feet, S. 49 1/2 E. 141 feet, S. 69 1/2 E. 173 feet, N. 76 E. 251 feet, S. 42 E. 42 feet, S. 89 E. 200 feet; thence leaving said branch N. 51 E. 354 feet; thence N. 35.35 E. 972 feet to a stake; thence due west 1275 feet to a stake; thence N. 5 1/4 W. 205 feet to a stake; thence N. 8 W. 225 feet; to a stake; thence N. 24 3/4 E. 183 feet to a stake; thence N. 29.50 W. 272 feet to a stake; thence N. 26 1/2 W. 182 feet to an iron pin in center of Gap Creek Road; thence along the center of said road S. 50 W. 525 feet to the beginning.

The above property is the same as conveyed to the late B.J. Odom by Ellen W. Crain by deed dated December 12, 1942, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Spartanburg County in Deed Book 249, at page 400.

The grantors herein are the sole heirs at law of B.J. Odom who died intestate in the County of Greenville, S.C., on April 24, 1950. All grantors are sui juris.
