All that lot of land with the improvements thereon situate on the West side of South Estate Drive, in Gantt Township, Greenville County, S.C. shown as Lot # 32 on Plat of Crestwood Inc. recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book "S" at Page 189, and having, according to said plat and a recent survey made by R. K. Campbell, Surveyor, Jan. 31, 1951, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

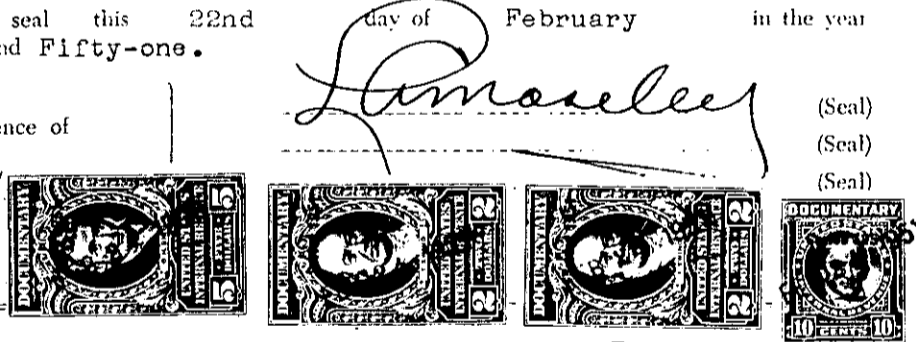
