

Hindman, Individually, all my right, title and interest, the same being a one-seventh interest in and to all those tracts of land conveyed to me by Lucy L. Hindman by deed dated April 15, 1949, recorded on the same date in Deed Book 379 at Page 217; also my oneseventh interest in the same land conveyed to me by Henry L. Hindman by deed dated May 6, 1949 and recorded on May 7, 1949 in Deed Book 380 at Page 511, thus making a two-sevenths interest in the above land which is herein conveyed to said grantee; also my one-seventh interest in all those tracts of lands conveyed to me by Lucy L. Hindman January 30, 1950 by deed recorded in the office of R.M.C. for Greenville County, January 31, 1950 in Deed Book 401 at Page 353, reference being made to said deeds for a full and complete description of the property herein conveyed.

Also to the said Henry L. Hindman as Trustee for Lucy Lee
Hindman, all the one-seventh interest in the same property above mentioned which was vested in me as Trustee for Lucy Lee Hindman by the
third deed hereinabove mentioned, and subject to all the terms and
conditions expressed in said trust deed to me.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and Singular the interest and the premises above mentioned which I am conveying individually to the said Henry L. Hindman, his Heirs and assigns forever, and

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the one-seventh interest which I as Trustee
