Hawkins, Sr., and his heirs and assigns:

All of that parcel or tract of land situate and being in Highland Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, lying on the West side of McCool's Beaverdam Creek and on both sides of Ridge Road, about nine miles North from the City of Greer, bounded on the North by lands of J.L. Hawkins, Sr., and lands of Mr. and Mrs. Wade H. Bradburn, on the East by Beaverdam Creek, on the South by lands of Gentry Babb, Floyd Babb and Palmer Smith, and on the West by lands of J.L. 
