This Agreement and Lease made this 28th day of March, 1951, by
and between Robert H. Dacus, Jr. and Florence H. Dacus, individually and as
executors of the estate of R. H. Dacus, hereinafter referred to as the Lessors
and Eugene Burns and C. C. Windman, Jr., hereinafter referred to as the Lessees,

L E A S E D E A L Y

That for and in consideration of the rental hereinabove stated, the
Lessors have granted, bargained, released, devised and by these presents do
hereby grant, bargain, lease and demise unto the Lessees the following
described property to-wit:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being at
the Northwesterly corner of the intersection of Cedar Lane Road and 17th Street,
near the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being shown as a lot on
the plat of property of Victor L. and Ellis wife by Mitchell & Mitchell,
Engineers, dated March 17, 1950, said lot fronting 126.9 feet on the Northwesterly
side of Cedar Lane Road and having a depth of 125 feet on the easterly side,
a depth of 125.4 feet on the westerly side along 17th Street and 132.5
feet across the rear.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto the Lessees for and during the term of
five (5) years, commencing on the first day of April, 1951 and ending on the
31st day of March, 1956, with the optional renewal for one year thereafter
provided.

The Lessees hereby covenant and agree to pay unto the Lessors the sum of
ten dollars hereinabove stated and to pay therefor unto the Lessors the sum of Six
Thousand and no/100 (\$6,000.00) Dollars rental in arrears on the first day of
One Hundred and no/100 (\$.100.00) Dollars each month until discontinued which
be paid before the 10th day of each month, the interest on which payment to
be paid no later than April 10, 1951.

The parties hereto hereby agree that the lessors shall have first
refusal of re-leasing this property upon the expiration of this lease, provided
