All those certain pieces, parcels or tracts of land in Bates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Tracts Numbers Two, Three and Four (Nos. 2, 3 and 4) on a plat made by W. A. Hester, Sur., January 17, 1924, said Tract No. 2 containing One Hundred One and one-half (1012) acres, more or less, Tract No. 3 containing Two Hundred Twenty Two and one-half (2222) acres, more or less, and Tract No. 4 containing Thirty Two and onehalf (322) acres, more or less.

The said Tract No. 2 is subject to a right-of-way for a road along the western line, down to the Ten (10) acre tract shown on said plat.
