Dear Mr and Mrs Cannon:-

This letter will confirm our recent conversation and give you permission to connect with our water system on Paris Mountain. Said water to be free.

In consideration of free water it is hereby agreed and understood that you are to pay one-half the cost of tank and Automatic Electric pump and pump house, and your pro-rata share of the electric bill for operation of said pump, maintenance and repairs.

Further if we think it advisable for fire protection to erect a tank to an elevation that will give a good gravity flow, you will bear one-half the cost of same.

Also, if, for any reason you decide not to build you will sell this property to me at the price you paid.

This agreement becomes null and void, if, and when you dispose of this property.
