to accumulate, furnish and sell water; to own and operate warehouses,

a farm; to own and license patents, copyrights, trade marks, licenses,
etc., to engage in the business of transporting freight by motor car-
rier for hire, and to do all the things incident to or appertaining to
the maintenance, operation, and conduct of any business relating to the
