County, State of South Carolina, and known as tract 3, containing 17.11 acres, of the Estate of J. B. Hawkins, Jr. according to plat filed by Wilson and Neves in January, 1949, and more particularly described according to said plat as follows:

beginning at a point in a road, 22 feet from iron fence line of said road, joint corners of tracts 4 and 5, whence 17-30-15 feet along line of tract 4 to a point, whence 17-30-15 feet along tract 4 to corner thereof, whence S 1-3° E 2-3°, to a point on line of tract 3 to a point on the N. W. L. B.
