Tidwell as the Board of Trustees of Parker School District, in consideration of the premises and of One (\$1.00) Dollar paid to the said Board, do hereby agree with the said Claude M. Long and with the said James T. Reid and Lucile B. Reid, their heirs and assigns, that the Northeasterly line of the school property hereinabove referred to and the Southwesterly lines of Lots 17 and 26, Section 2, of the Dunean Mills Village shall be as shown on the plat entitled "Subdivision for Dunean Mills, Greenville, S. C." made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, Greenville, S. C., and recorded in the R. M. C.
