does grant, bargain, sell and release unto R. E. Hughes, his heirs and assigns, for-
ever:

All that right-of-way and easement over and across a strip of land
fifty (50) feet in width extending in a Southeasterly direction from
the rear line of Lot 2 on Map of Cleveland Forest, recorded in the
R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "1", at page
137, said easement having been given for the purpose of laying one or
more sewer lines through, over and across that certain tract of land
situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, containing
34.20 acres, more or less, and more particularly described in the deed
from B. B. Balentine, et al, dated September 20, 1949, recorded in the
said R. M. C. Office in Deed Book 392, at page 130, to R. E. Hughes.
The area affected by said easement extending 20 feet east of and parallel
to the proposed center line of said sewer pipe line and 30 feet east of
and parallel to the proposed center line of said sewer pipe line, and
being more particularly described in right-of-way deed of B. B.
Balentine, et al, to the Grantor herein, dated September 20, 1949, re-
corded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book
393, at page 287.

The Grantee, R. E. Hughes, is the owner of the tract of land affected
by the above mentioned right-of-way, and the purpose of this conveyance
is to extinguish and terminate all rights acquired by the Grantor in,
over and across said property by the deed last above mentioned.
