(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said T. P. Farmer and H. A. Dill, their heirs and assigns forever:-

All my right, title, interest and estate, at law or in equity, by way of dower or otherwise, of, in and to that certain tract or parcel of land in Glassy Mountain Township, said County and State, lying on both sides of the Tugalo Road, on the north side of the Middle Tyger River and southwest side of Morgan Creek, about four miles west of Gowansville, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:-

Beginning on a stone in the bank of Middle Tyger River, thence up said River to a stake; thence Northwest 50 links to intersection of the River and a Creek; thence with Creek to the Tugaloo Road; thence with said road, S 69-00 W 1 ch. 31 links to point in said road; thence N 33-0 W 6.38 chs to a stone; thence N 47-45 W 3.5 chains to stone; thence N 2.15 E 1 ch. to a stone; thence N 22-00 E 2 chs to stone; thence N 57-00 E 1.50 chs to a
