Know All Men by These Presents:

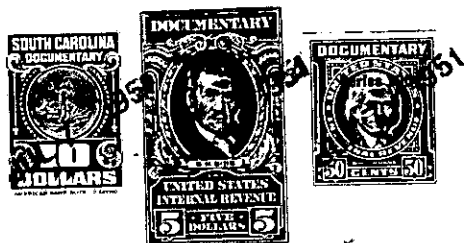
That I, Henry O. Gault in the State aforesaid,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said T. A. Putman, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Southern side of Circle Street, near the City of Greenville, being shown as lot No. 22, on plat of Hillside Heights, made by R.E. Dalton, Engineer, in September 1923, recorded in Plat Book F at Page 100, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Southern side of Circle Street, corner of lot 21, and running thence with the Southern side of Circle Street, S. 70-55 W. 60 feet to a stake, corner of lot 23; thence with line of said lot, S. 5-51 E. 150 feet to a stake in line of Williams property; thence with line of said property, N. 72-41 E. 110 feet to stake, corner of lot 21; thence with line of said lot, N. 25-03 W. 150 feet to the beginning.
