Peeples, her heirs and assigns forever:

All that tract of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the Old Hundred School, being more particularly described according to a recent survey prepared by J. C. Hill, April 7, 1951, as follows:

BEGINNING at a nail and cap in the center of a county road, and running thence N. 4-30 W. 1172 feet to a stake near a branch; thence S. 64-45 E. 428 feet to a stake near a branch; thence S. 20-15 W. 501 feet to a stone; thence S. 15-55 E. 641 feet crossing the county road to an iron pin; thence S. 74-55 E. 501 feet to a stone; thence S. 38-15 W. 513 feet to a stone; thence S. 78-30 W. 356 feet to a stone; thence N. 43-35 W. 937.5 feet to a nail and cap in the center of county road; thence N. 86-20 E. 588 feet to the beginning corner, containing in the aggregate 16.88 acres, more or less.
