DAMAGE PAYMENT AFFIDAVIT

The undersigned, being of lawful age and first duly sworn, upon oath deposes and says:

That he is employed as the Eastern Division Right Of Way Supervisor for The Plantation Pipe Line Company, with temporary Construction Offices for said Eastern Division being located at 121 Sharpe Street, Anderson, South Carolina.

AFFIANT STATES that the Right of Way File Records in the said offices contain a Right of Way Grant to the said Plantation Pipe Line Company, said grant being executed on the 10th day of July, 1941, by Mrs. Lyl T. Coates Grantor, covering lands located in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being more particularly described in the said grant recorded in Book 237 at Page 15, of the records of said County.

AFFIANT FURTHER STATES that the right of way file in the said office and covering the aforesaid tract of land above described, contains a duly executed Receipt and Release executed on the 26th day of January, 1951, by W. Sam Coates, Sr., J. E. Coates, U.S.N., the then owner of said lands, accepting the consideration cited therein as \$40.00 as advance partial payment for partial release and forever discharge to Plantation Pipe Line Company, its successors, assigns, agents and servants, from all claims and demands for damages of every kind and character which the said owner, his successors, assigns, heirs and personal representatives now have or may have in the future against the said company arising out of the construction of a second pipe line across the above referred to lands.

AFFIANT FINALLY STATES that the execution and the recording of this affidavit is for the purpose of serving notice on all third parties who might become interested in the title to the above referred to lands that the aforesaid damage payment has been made.
