This Lease made and entered into this 10th day of February, 1951, by and between Burnette H. Cole, hereinafter called the Lessor, and Wilfred T. Blackwell, hereinafter called the Lessee.

WITNESSETH

That for and in consideration rents and of the mutual covenants, promises, and agreements hereinafter contained, it is agreed as follows:

- (1) That the Lessor hereby grants, bargains, and leases unto the Lessee and the Lessee does hereby lease, hire, and accept from the Lessor the building and all fixtures and equipment located on the premises of 1296 Pendleton Street, known as Cole's Cafe, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina;
