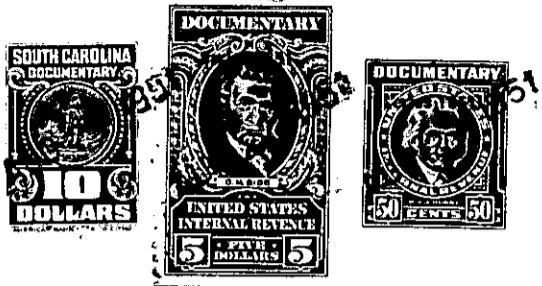

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, lying on the south side of S.C. Highway No. 414 about two miles west from Tigerville, S. C., and being shown and designated as lots no. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 on a plat of the property of Lora T. Burry, plat made by H. S. Brockman, surveyor, and dated July 24, 1951, and having, according to said plat, the following courses and distances, to wit:
