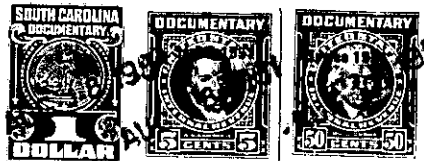
All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the North side of High Valley Boulevard near the City of Greenville, in Gantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot 19 on plat of Fresh Meadow Farms, made by M. H. Woodward, May 21, 1945, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "M" at page 127, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of High Valley Boulevard at joint front corner of Lots 18 and 19, and running thence with the line of Lot 18, N 8-37 E 250 feet to an iron pin; thence S 81-23 E 87 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 20, S 8-37 W 250 feet to the North side of High Valley Boulevard; thence along the North side of High Valley Boulevard, N 81-23 W 87 feet to the beginning corner.
