

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being near the City of Greer, in the County of Spartanburg, State of South Carolina, in the Apalache Plant Village of Victor-Monaghan Company as shown on plat entitled "Property of Victor Monaghan Co., Apalache Plant, Greer, S. C.", made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, February, 1951, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Spartanburg County in Plat Book 27, at page 212, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Southeastern corner of the intersection of Arlington Street and Church Street, and running thence along the Southern side of Arlington Street S. 73-13 E. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along Arlington Street S. 75-37 E. 65 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot 97, Section 1, per plat of the Apalache Village recorded in Plat Book 26, at page 29; thence along the line of said Lot 97, S. 17-12 W. 151.2 feet to an iron pin on a 12 foot alley; thence along said 12 foot alley N. 86-04 W. 82 feet to an iron pin at the rear of said alley; thence along the rear of said alley S. 3-54 W. 10.9 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot 117, Section 1, per said plat recorded in Plat Book 26, at page 29; thence along line of Lot 117 N. 80-26 W. 107 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern side of Church Street; thence along the Eastern side of Church Street N. 27-56 E. 176.4 feet to an iron pin; thence around a curve, the chord of which is N. 63-04 E. 26.2 feet, to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
