Thank you very much for your letter of May 30, 1951.

As we set out in our letter of May 26, Section 7177 provides that these public warehouse bonds should be recorded in the office of Clerk of Court. However, Section 3628, Code of 1942, sets up the office of Register of Mesne Conveyance in Charleston, Spartanburg and Greenville Counties. Section 3629 has the title "Clerk of Court in other counties shall perform duties here imposed on such register". I take it that in these counties these papers are to be recorded in the office of Register of Mesne Conveyance.

It would certainly seem to appear that in your county the duties of recording these papers are taken over by the Register of Mesne Conveyance.
