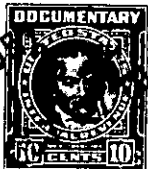

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That I, Jerry H. Glenn, of

Greenville County

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Four thousand, three hundred-
ninety nine and 68/100 (\$4,399.68) Dollars
and assumption of mortgage for \$3600.32 to First Federal Savings & Loan Ass'n
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents

by William E. Hunt

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said William E. Hunt, his heirs
and assigns forever;

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, on the east side of Donneybrook street, and
being known and designated as Lot No. 16 in a subdivision known
as McCullough Heights, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the
R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book E, at page 95,
and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of Donneybrook
street at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 16 and 17, which point
is 61 feet from the intersection of Donneybrook Street and Bentwood
Street, and running thence along the east side of Donneybrook
Street, N. 32-20 E. 75 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot
No. 15; thence along the line of Lot No. 15, S. 58-27 E. 185.8
feet to an iron pin in line of Lot No. 13; thence along the line
of said Lot no. 13, S. 32-30 W. 75 feet to an iron pin at the rear
corner of Lot No. 17; thence along the line of said Lot No.
17, N. 58-27 W. 185.7 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described lot is shown on the Township Block Book
at Sheet No. 156, Block 1, Lot No. 15.

The grantee herein does hereby expressly assume and agree
