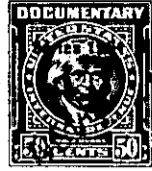

IN THE COUNTY COURT

To All Whom These Presents Shall Come:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Claude Henson

on or about the 12th day of May in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and fifty-one exhibited his
County
complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against

Elma E. Henson, et al,

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to
be heard on the 12th day of September 1951,
and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged
and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN,
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to W. L. Staggs
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$3200.00

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said W. L. Staggs

"All that certain tract, lot or boundary of land lying and being in
Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County and State of South Carolina,
having the following description. all the land owned by L. C. Henson lying
on the north of Middle Tyger River and joins the Lister Estate on the East,
Landrum Davis on the north and Hattie E. Moon on the West, known as the
Brady Tract and the Langley Tract.

ALSO: all that land lying north of Middle Tyger River and runs with
Hattie E. Morrow's line on the east and W. H. Henson on the west also on
the north, known as the John Henson Tract of land. These two boundaries
contain 140 acres, more or less.

Less, However, 30 acres described in paragraph four of the complaint
and conveyed by me as Master to Hattie Myrtle Henson Barton pursuant to the
Order of Court herein.
