Know all men by these presents that for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty Seven and 80/100 (\$87.80), paid to Elizabeth H. Hair, Net 1 H. Hewell, Is Executrixes of the Estate of John D. Harris, deceased., Mary Elizabeth Warris.
(hereinafter designated grantor), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the grantor hereby bargains, sells and conveys unto Piedmont Natural Gas Company, Incorporated, a New York corporation (hereinafter designated grantee), and its successors and assignees, a right-of-way and easement for the purposes of laying, constructing, maintaining, operating, repairing, altering, replacing and removing pipe lines (with valves, regulators, meters, fittings, appliances, tie-overs, and appurtenant facilities) for the transportation of gas, oil, petroleum products, or any other liquids, gases, or substances which can be transported through a pipe line, the Grantee to have the right to select the route (the laying of the first pipe line to constitute the selection of the route by the Grantee), under, upon, over, through and across the lands of Grantor, or in which the Grantor has an interest situate in
County, (or devised by the will recorded in Wills Book 469 page 29 in the office of the Probate Court of Greenville County), and described as follows:
All that certain tract of land in Gantt Township, being approximately 300 acres, bounded on the North by farm road and property of Charles T. Merritt, on the East by property of the United States, on the West by county road and property of R. C. Ashmore, and on the South by property of Charles T. Merritt and Mrs. John Ridgeway and an old unused road, being part of the property of John D. Harris, deceased, willed to the present owners. (See Apartment 469, File 29, Office of the Probate Judge for Greenville County).
This conveyance made by virtue of the power given in the will of John D. Harris, deceased, and is deemed by the undersigned to be advisable and in the best interest of the Estate of John D. Harris, deceased.
We the undersigned hereby designate and appoint Mary Elizabeth Harris to receive and distribute all sums under the term of this instrument.
There is included in this grant the right from time to time to lay, construct, maintain, operate, alter, repair, remove, change the size of, and replace at any time or from time to time one or more additional lines of pipe and appurtenances thereto including without limitation corrosion control equipment; provided, however, that for each additional line laid after the first line is laid the grantee shall pay the grantor or his heirs or assignees \$1.00 per lineal rod of additional pipe line laid under, upon, over or thru the aforedescribed land, or such proportionate part thereof as the grantor's interest in said land bears to the entire ownership thereof.
The grantee shall have all other rights and benefits necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use of the rights herein granted, including without limitation the free and full right of ingress and egress over and across said lands and other lands of the grantor to and from the area specifically covered by this grant of easement, and the right from time to time to cut all trees, undergrowth and other obstructions that may injure, endanger or interfere with the construction, operation, maintenance and repair of said pipe lines; and the grantee shall have the right to assign this grant in whole or in part.
To have and to hold said right-of-way and easement unto said grantee, its successors and assignees, until such first pipe line be constructed and so long thereafter as a pipe line is maintained upon said land, and the undersigned hereby bind themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assignees to warrant and forever defend all and singular said premises unto the grantee, its successors and assignees, against the claims of all persons whomsoever.
The grantee hereby agrees to bury all pipes to a sufficient depth so as not to interfere with cultivation of the soil, and agrees to pay such damages as may arise to growing crops, timber, or fences from the construction, maintenance and operation of said pipe lines; such damage, if not mutually agreed upon, to be ascertained and determined by three disinterested persons, one to be appointed by the undersigned, successors, heirs or assignees, one by the grantee, its successors or assignees, and the third by the two persons aforesaid, and the award of such three persons, or any two of them, shall be final and conclusive.
The grantor may fully use and enjoy said land and premises, except for the purposes granted to the grantee and provided the grantor shall not construct nor permit to be constructed any house, structures or obstructions on or over, or that will interfere with the construction, maintenance or operation of, any pipe line or appurtenances constructed hereunder, and will not change the grade over such pipe line.
All payments hereunder may be made direct to the grantor or to
The grantor represents that the above described land is rented to until
It is understood and acknowledged by the undersigned that the person securing this grant is without authority to make any agreement with regard to the subject matter hereof which is not expressed herein, and that no such agreement will be binding on the grantee.
