WHEREAS, Carolina Lake Colony, Inc., is the owner of a said clear water lake located in Saluda Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, which is an integral part of Carolina Lake Colony and adjacent; and

WHEREAS, Paul B. Pritchard, Jr. and Ruth F. Pritchard, do agree to purchase a house and lot near said lake, the same being known and designated as Lot No. 8 on Plat recorded in Plat Book C of Greenville, the same to be conveyed by a separate deed from I. J. Davis; and one of the conditions of said purchase was that they and their heirs and assigns shall have the same rights and privileges to the use and enjoyment of the lake and the joys enjoyed by the purchasers of lots in the subdivision immediately adjacent to said lake.

NOW THEREFORE, Carolina Lake Colony, Inc., for and in consideration of five dollars and the above recitals in hand paid, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Paul B. Pritchard, Jr., and Ruth F. Pritchard, their heirs and assigns forever:

The right and privilege to the lake and an adjoining acre of land in Carolina Lake for the purpose of swimming, boating and fishing. It being distinctly understood that the rights, title and privileges herein granted shall run with the ownership of Lot No. 8 above referred to, and is subject to transfer and sale by the grantees, their heirs and assigns, so long as all subsequent purchasers of said lot.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the rights, title and privileges hereinabove granted unto the grantees, their heirs and assigns forever.

AND the grantor does hereby bind itself, its successors and assigns, to warrant and forever defend the aforesaid title and unto the grantees, their heirs and assigns, against the grantor and every other person lawfully claiming or to claim any part hereof.
