THIS AGREMENT, Made and entered into this / day of Moderation, 1951, by and between GREENVILLE AND NORTHERN RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of South Carolina, party of the first part, hereinafter called the "Railway Company", and GREATER GREENVILLE SEWER DISTRICT, a body corporate and politic organized under the laws of the State of South Carolina, party of the second part, hereinafter called the "Sewer District",

## WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Sewer District proposes to construct a sewer line from the property line between the Railway Company and Ward S. Stone and 10 feet south of the property line of the Railway Company and the Piedmont and Northern Railway Company, crossing the property of the Railway Company to Hudson Street, a distance of 497.5 feet, as shown by a red line on the attached print, dated Feb. 1951-Revised 6-29-51, which print is made a part of this agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the agreements on the part of the Sewer District to be performed as hereinafter set out, the parties have agreed and do agree as fellows:

- 1. The Railway Company, so far as it is authorized, does hereby grant and convey unto the Sewer District, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, maintain and operate said sewer line hereinabove referred to, being a 42" sewer line.
- 2. The Sewer District agrees that in the construction of said sewer line over the land of the Railway Company, as indicated on the attached print, the work shall be done and thereafter be maintained in accordance with reasonable requirements of the Railway Company looking to the safe and convenient operation and maintenance of its property for railroad purposes.
- 3. It is agreed that in event the Railway Company shall at any time hereafter during the life of this agreement, make any changes
