to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Carl R. Brown and Ruth Brown, their heirs and assigns forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina being known and designated as Lot No. 122 of a subdivision known as Section "A", of Englewood Estates, as shown by a Plat thereof, dated October, 1951, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book, "Y", at Page 140.

BEGINNING at an iron pin joint corner of Lots No. 122 and 124 and running thence along the line of said Lot No. 124, S. 87-30 E. 142 feet to iron pin at back corner of Lot No. 123; thence along the rear line of Lot No. 123 at an angle N. 13-15 W. 104.7 feet to iron pin at back corner of Lot No. 120; thence along the line of said Lot No. 120, N. 87-30 W. 172.7 feet to iron pin on Evelyn Drive; thence with the line of said Evelyn Drive S. 28-59 E. 117.2 feet to point of beginning.

2. No house is to be built closer than 50 feet to the street.
3. No temporary house is to be erected on said lot.
