all that piece, parcel or lot of land in
County, State of South Carolina, located about three miles north of Greenville,
S. C., on the east side of the Greenville River, (known as
West-Booster's Head road), the same being more particularly
described in a plat of the County of Greenville, South Carolina,
made by J. I. Burkhoo, Surveyor, State of South Carolina,
in and for the County of Greenville, S. C., and
incorporated herein by reference, to which plat reference is made,
to wit:

That the said piece, parcel or lot of land is bounded on the north by the
river, on the east by the Greenville River, on the south by the
road, and on the west by the Greenville River, and the same is
more particularly described in the plat of the County of Greenville,
