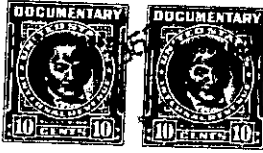

Know All Men by These Presents:

That R. E. Hughes in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Six Hundred and No/100 (\$1,600.00) in the State aforesaid, DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Sybil P. Baker, her heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being on the Southwest side of East Faris Road, in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 86 on Plat of Forest Heights, made by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, 1946, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "P", at page 71, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwest side of East Faris Road at joint front corners of Lots 85 and 86 and running thence with the line of Lot 85 S. 82-34 W. 162.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 26-00 E. 111.5 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 87 N. 71-55 E. 155.5 feet to an iron pin on the Southwest side of East Faris Road; thence along the Southwest side of East Faris Road N. 24-37 W. 30 feet to the beginning corner.
