Howell in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five (\$5.00) DOLLARS, and love and affection for the grantee Mrs. Pearl Wilson Howell to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs Pearl Wilson Howell and her heirs and assigns:

All of that parcel or lot of land in the City of Greer, in Chick Springs Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, lying on the East side of Lanford Street, being the smaller portion of Lot No. 15 on a plat of land known as Westmoreland Circle prepared by W.J. Riddle, Surveyor, December, 1921, and having the following courses and distances: BEGINNING on a stake on the eastern margin of Lanford Street, joint corner of Lots Nos. 15 and 16 on said plat, and runs thence with the common line of these lots S. 62.20 E. 150 feet to a stake, joint rear corner of said lots; thence S. 17.40 W. 10 feet to a point, corner with lot this day conveyed by us to Henry S. Beck, Jr. on common rear line of lots Nos. 7 and 15; thence a new line along lot conveyed by us to Beck N. 62.20 W. 150 feet to a point on the eastern margin of Lanford Street; thence therewith S. 17.40 W. 10 feet to the beginning corner, and being the smaller portion of that lot conveyed to us by the grantee herein by deed dated February 11, 1941, recorded in Deed Book 428, at page 235, in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s') Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
