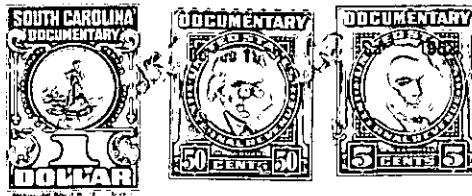

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina. known and designated as Lot No. 124 Meadow Street in a Subdivision of property of P. R. Long and Walter W. Goldsmith known as Newtown according to plat made by Dalton & Neves in May 1944 and recorded in Plat Book "O", at page 21, RMC Office for Greenville County and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Meadow Street at the joint front corner of Lots 122 and 124 and running thence along Meadow Street, South 2-45 East 35 feet to an iron pin; thence North 87-15 East 75 feet to an iron pin; running thence North 2-45 West 35 feet to an iron pin; running thence South 87-15 West 75 feet to the beginning corner.
