PARCEL - 14: All that certain tract of land in Cleveland Township, Greenville County, and Saluda Township, County aforesaid, State of South Carolina, containing 155 acres, more or less, situate lying and being on waters of Beaver Dam Creek and adjoining lands hereinabove designated as "No. D-IV, C.C. Goode", and shown as "No. B-XIII, S. L. Styles" on Wiswall plat mentioned above, reference to which plat is hereby craved for a complete and accurate description of the area, metes and bounds of said property.

PARCEL - 15: All that certain tract of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 83 acres, more or less, situate, lying and being on Beaver Dam Creek, adjoining lands now or formerly of R. C. Remick and lands of the Grantor, as fully described on plat mentioned above as "No. C-XI, Betty Fowler", reference to which plat is hereby craved for a complete and accurate description of the area, metes and bounds, of said property.

PARCEL - 16: All that certain tract of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 105 acres, more or less, lying and being on both sides of Beaver Dam Creek, waters of North Saluda River, being the same land conveyed to L. M. Carlson by Matthew Bruce, under deed dated January 12, 1920, recorded in the said R. M. C. Office in Deed Book 68, at page 2, as shown on the Wiswall plat mentioned above as "Matthew Bruce, 82½ ac.", reference to which plat is hereby craved for a complete and accurate description of the area, metes and bounds of said property.

There is expressly excluded from this tract the following:
 (a) 20 acres, more or less, heretofore conveyed by Matthew Bruce to William Thompson.

The tract herein conveyed contains approximately 82½ acres, being the same conveyed to the Grantor by Deed of L. M. Carlson, dated Feb. 16, 1920, recorded in the said R. M. C. Office in Deed Book 68, at page 40.
