hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto J. T. JENKINS,
his heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being
in Butler Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as
Lot No. 8 on the Plat of College Heights made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, re-
corded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "P",
page 75, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, courses
and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of East North Street
Extension at the joint front corners of Lots 7 and 8, and running
thence S33-10E 200 feet to an iron pin; thence N56-50E 75 feet to
an iron pin; thence N33-10W 200 feet to an iron pin on East North
Street Extension; thence with East North Street Extension S56-50W
75 feet to the beginning corner.

The property hereby conveyed is a portion of the property conveyed to
Victory Textiles (now McCall Manufacturing Company) by deed of Modern Industries of
Greenville, South Carolina, dated December 20, 1948, recorded in the R.M.C. Office
