

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Margaret McKissick Cleveland, her heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Southwest side of Southland Avenue in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot 12 on Plat No. 2 of Property of W. C. Cleveland, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, June 1935, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "H", at page 289, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwest side of Southland Avenue at joint front corner of Lots 11 and 12, said point being 35 feet in a Southeasterly direction from the point where the Southwest side of Southland Avenue intersects with the South side of Woodland Way, and running thence with the line of Lot 11 Due South 325 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 89-51 E. 20.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 63-24 E. 210.5 feet to an iron pin in the Southwest side of Southland Avenue; thence along the Southwest side of Southland Avenue N. 40-15 W. 322 feet to the beginning corner.

This property is conveyed subject to the following building restrictions:

This property shall be used for residential purposes only.

2. No dwelling shall be built on said lot costing less than \$10,000.00

3. No building shall be constructed on said lot nearer than 75 feet

to Woodland Way.

This lot shall not be re-cut so as to face any direction other than Woodland Way, provided, however, should a street be opened so that the rear portion of the lot shall front thereon, then the Grantee, her heirs and assigns are permitted to cut said rear into suitable lots fronting on said street.

This property is a portion of the property that was owned by W. C. Cleveland at the time of his death on August 26, 1946, and this conveyance is made by the Grantors, as Executors under the will of W. C. Cleveland, under the power given the executors in the said will to make conveyance of a portion of the corpus of the said estate to testator's wife, Alice Burnett Cleveland, all of which is shown by the will dated January 17, 1940, on file in the Probate Court for Greenville County, S. C., in Apartment 518, File 29.
