

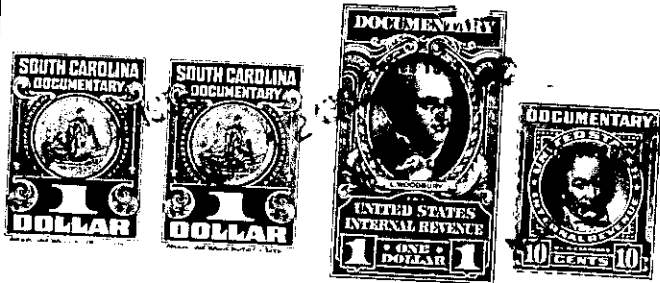

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said P. D. CUNNINGHAM

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in BUTLER Township, GREENVILLE County, State of South Carolina

The same being a portion of that land conveyed to R. A. Hudson from T. H. and R. A. Hudson, Executors, to R. A. Hudson on May 17 1934 and recorded in Vol 177 Page 206, in The R. M. C. office of Greenville County S. C. and having the following description:

Beginning at an iron pin which is a joint corner between R. A. Hudson property and P. D. Cunningham property and running S 48°-0' E 1067 feet to a point which is in the center of HUDSON ROAD over a culvert; thence S 4°-00'E, 437 feet to an iron pin; Thence N 35°-00'W, 357.2 feet to an iron pin which is on the North right of way line of Hudson Road; Thence still N 35°-00' W 1070.2 feet to an iron pin which was the point of beginning. The area included being three and seventy four one-hundredths acres as shown on a plat made by Woodward Engineering Company, Greenville, S. C. Feb. 1952 and designated thereon as tract 24A.
