

to the grantor(it) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(in) (the receipt whereof is hereby ---- Dollars, acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto JOE L. CLEMENT:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on Piney Mountain near the City of Greenville, S. C. on the Southeastern size of View Point Drive, being described according to a plat prepared by Fiedmont Engineering Service, Greenville, S. C. Dated April 22, 1952, entitled "Fromerty of J. E. Gilliam, Piney Mountain, Near Greenville, S. C.", and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point near the center of View Point Drive at the joint corner of the within conveyed premises and other property of the grantor, and running thence S. 35-20 E. 278.8 feet to an iron pin in the line of the tracerty now or formerly of Wallace; thence S. 84-16 W. 120.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 35-20 W. 222.7 feet to a point near the center of View Point prive; thence along View Point Drive N. 56-32 E. 104.8 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described property consists of a portion of that property conveyed to the grantor by deed of Martha S. Scott dated November 26, 1942, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Volume 283 at rate 33°, a portion of that property conveyed to the grantor herein by accu of Jan H. ...allace, Jr. dated October 4, 1946 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Deed Volume 300 at page 233 and a portion of that property conveyed to J. E. Gilliam, Jr. by deed of Greenville County, S. C. dated Uctober 3, 1950 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Granville County in Deed Volume 420 at page 335.

The above described property is conveyed to the following restrictive covenants:

- The lot of land hereby conveyed shall be used exclusively for residential purposes.
- No surface closet or cesspool shall ever be used on said lot but only septic tanks or other sanitary sewers.
