

While this deed covers to center of road, and the adjacent property when sold, will be deed in a like manner, no owner or purchaser shall have the right to close or obstruct the road in any manner or do anything to prevent its use as a public highway, and the right is hereby given by seller and buyer that the road may be widened to as much as twenty feet from the center at any time by property owners or the state
